**Reread Nehemiah Passage Below**

<sup>1-2</sup>When Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall **he exploded in anger**, vilifying the Jews. In the company of his Samaritan cronies and military he let loose: "What are these miserable Jews doing? **Do they think they can get everything back to normal overnight?** Make building stones out of **make-believe?**" <sup>3</sup> At his side, Tobiah the Ammonite jumped in and said, "That's right! What do they think they're building? Why, if a fox climbed that wall, **it would fall to pieces under his weight.**"

<sup>6</sup> **We kept at it, repairing and rebuilding the wall.** The whole wall was soon joined together and halfway to its intended height because **the people had a heart for the work.**

<sup>7-9</sup> When the enemy heard that the repairs of the walls of Jerusalem were going so well—that the breaks in the wall were being fixed—**they were absolutely furious.** They put their heads together and decided to fight against Jerusalem and create as much trouble as they could. **We countered with prayer** to our God and set a round-the-clock guard against them.

<sup>10</sup> But soon word was going around in Judah, The builders are pooped, the rubbish piles up;

**We're in over our heads, we can't build this wall.**

When we are in the ring of life, fighting for a brother, we too will face opposition from the enemy which can be very discouraging. List 1 or more character traits that we will need to continue the noble fight for our brother.
