1. Our Daughters must see us as their \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Peter 3:7 <sup>7</sup>*Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered*
  
2. We are to protect our Daughters \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Samuel 16:7 <sup>7</sup>*But the LORD said to Samuel, “Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”*
  
3. We are to protect our Daughters \_\_\_\_\_ Ephesians 6:4 <sup>4</sup>*Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.*
  
4. Our Daughters must see us as their \_\_\_\_\_ Deuteronomy 6:7 <sup>7</sup>*Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.*
